For the last few years, in early December, organizations that involve disabled people and various agencies have organized meetings and exchange programmes to mark the three days in Vietnam.

This year UN agencies, the Hanoi Disabled People's Association and similar organizations will hold an exchange programme called "For the love of Life " on December 3rd at Thong Nhat park in Hanoi. The event is also in line with the UN General Assembly's upcoming approval of the " Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities " and the response to the call of the UN Economic and Social Commision for Asia and the Pacific (UNESCAP).

The program is for people such as disabled people, people living with HIV/ AIDS and enthusiastic volunteers who are actively supporting the disadvantaged **ones** as well as serving in other development areas. It is also aimed at enhancing the competence of the Hanoi Disabled People's Association and disabled people's organizations.

Attending the meeting are leaders of the government, involving ministries, committees and branches, ambassadors, representatives from international and non-governmental organizations, disabled people, people living with HIV/ AIDS; national and international volunteers.
