Stephen: This soup is amazing, Jenny. Do you use fresh tomatoes to make it?

Jenny: No, Stephen. I just use a can of tomatoes. Some people think roast

tomatoes are best, but that's too much hard work for me.

Jenny: Well, we're having fruit cake for dessert, and for main course we've

got pasta. I wanted to do lemon chicken, but I didn't have time.
